## **Pre Procedure Instructions**

## **MORNING APPOINTMENT:**

- 1. Make sure to have nothing to eat or drink after midnight prior to your procedure. Sips of water with morning medications are okay. Do not take your Aspirin or Plavix.
- 2. If you take Coumadin (Warfarin), please speak with your prescribing doctor regarding whether or not this medicine can be stopped prior to your procedure.
- 3. If you are a diabetic, use your best judgment when deciding on whether or not to take your insulin as you will not be eating prior to your procedure.
- 4. Bring all your medications or a current list with you to the appointment.
- 5. Bring insurance, Medicare, Medicaid cards with you.
- 6. Make sure you have a driver to take you home after the appointment. You may drive yourself to your procedure but we will only use local anesthetic if that is the case.
- 7. If you have an allergy to contrast dye, be sure to talk to your dialysis unit to get the premedications you need before your procedure.
- 8. If you have a DNR (do not resuscitate) Order, please bring a copy with you to your appointment.

## AFTERNOON APPOINTMENT:

If you have an afternoon appointment, please follow all of the instructions listed above. You may have a light breakfast but be sure to stop eating at least 6 hours before your appointment.
